- Build an international network of researchers and educators focusing on responsible business management.
- Strengthen collaboration between institutions to develop joint research projects, publications or teaching initiatives.
- Share and co-create innovative teaching and research approaches in sustainability and ethics.
- Enhance staff competencies through interactive learning and peer exchange.
- Promote the integration of sustainability and ethics into the core of business education curricula.

- Keynote presentations given by the three organising partners and eventually presentations presented by other participants.
- Research round-table discussions and hands-on workshops on business ethics, sustainability, SDGs in management etc.
- Project incubator where teams brainstorm and design joint project ideas, joint publications or proposals (courses, research, case development).
- Workshops and sharing best practices: peer learning circles on how to teach responsible business, case studies, gamification, exchange of educational programmes, innovative methods teaching materials and collaborative initiatives.
- Exchange of qualitative/quantitative methods for studying responsible business management.
